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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in January 1989 totaled 3.27 billion pounds up 1 percent from January 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for January 1989 included 22 weekdays (two holidays) and four Saturdays. Kill days for January 1988 consisted of 21 weekdays (two holidays) and five Saturdays.

COMPARING JANUARY 1989 WITH JANUARY 1988

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.90 billion pounds was down 3 percent. Head kill totaled 2.79 million, down 5 from last year. The average live weight increased 28 pounds to 1147.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 32.0 million pounds was unchanged from last year. Calf slaughter totaled 203 thousand head, down 5 percent, and the average live weight increased 17 pounds to 264.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.31 billion pounds was up 5 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.33 million head, up 5 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 249.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 27.0 million pounds was up 13 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 429 thousand head, up 10 percent. The average live weight increased 4 pounds to 126.
