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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in April 1989 totaled 3.13 billion pounds down 1 percent from April 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-April red meat production, at 12.7 billion pounds was down 1 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1988 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 3; veal, down 6 ; pork up 3 ; lamb and mutton, up 2. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for April 1989 included 20 weekdays and five Saturdays. Kill days for April 1988 consisted of 21 weekdays and five Saturdays.

## COMPARING APRIL 1989 WITH APRIL 1988

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.76 billion pounds was down 5 percent. Head kill totaled 2.64 million, down 5 from last year. The average live weight increased 9 pounds to 1115.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 27.0 million pounds was down 4 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 158 thousand head, down 11 percent, and the average live weight increased 21 pounds to 286.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.32 billion pounds was up 5 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.38 million head, up 4 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 250.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 26.0 million pounds was the same as last year. Slaughter totaled 409 thousand head, up 1 percent. The average live weight was 126 the same as last year.
