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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in May 1989 totaled 3.40 billion pounds, up 8 percent from April 1989, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-May red meat production, at 16.1 billion pounds was up 1 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1988 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, down 5; pork up 4; lamb and mutton, up 2. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for May 1989 included 23 weekdays (one holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for May 1988 consisted of 22 weekdays (one holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING MAY 1989 WITH MAY 1988

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.00 billion pounds was up 4 percent. Head kill totaled 3.02 million, up 4 from last year. The average live weight increased 3 pounds to 1,105.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 29.0 million pounds was down 3 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 163 thousand head, down 9 percent, and the average live weight increased 15 pounds to 294.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.34 billion pounds was up 9 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.48 million head, up 9 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 251.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 28.0 million pounds was up 4 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 447 thousand head, up 5 percent. The average live weight decreased 1 pound to 125.
