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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in June 1989 totaled 3.34 billion pounds, up 1 percent from June 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-June red meat production, at 19.5 billion pounds was up 1 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1988 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, down 7; pork up 4; lamb and mutton, up 2. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for June 1989 included 22 weekdays (no holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for June 1988 consisted of 22 weekdays (no holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING JUNE 1989 WITH JUNE 1988

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.02 billion pounds was nearly the same as last year. Head kill totaled 3.03 million, down 1 from last year. The average live weight increased 11 pounds to 1,116.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 29.0 million pounds was down 15 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 167 thousand head, down 21 percent, while the average live weight increased 18 pounds to 283.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.27 billion pounds was up 3 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.08 million head, up 3 percent. The average live weight was the same as last year at 250.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 26.0 million pounds was down 4 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 437 thousand head, up 2 percent. The average live weight decreased 5 pounds to 119.
