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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in July 1989 totaled 3.05 billion pounds, down 4 percent from July 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January - July red meat production, at 22.5 billion pounds was nearly the same as last year. The percentage changes from 1988 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, down 8; pork up 3; lamb and mutton, up 2. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for July 1989 included 21 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays. Kill days for July 1988 consisted of 21 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays.

COMPARING JULY 1989 WITH JULY 1988

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.89 billion pounds was down 5 percent. Head kill totaled 2.79 million, down 6 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 11 pounds to 1,124.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 27.0 million pounds was down 13 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 174 thousand head, down 19 percent, and the average live weight increased 13 pounds to 257.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.11 billion pounds was down 2 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.29 million head, down 1 percent. The average live weight decreased 3 pounds to 246.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 25.0 million pounds was up 4 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 413 thousand head, up 2 percent. The average live weight decreased 2 pounds to 119.
