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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in August 1989 totaled 3.48 billion pounds, down 1 percent from August 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-August red meat production, at 26.0 billions pounds, was nearly the same as last year. The percentage changes from 1988 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, down 9; pork up 3; lamb and mutton, up 2. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for August 1989 included 23 weekdays (no holiday) and four Saturdays, the same as August 1988.

COMPARING AUGUST 1989 WITH AUGUST 1988

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.09 billion pounds was down 3 percent. Head kill totaled 3.05 million, down 5 from last year. The average live weight increased 18 pounds to 1,141.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 29.0 million pounds was down 17 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 195 thousand head, down 17 percent. The average live weight increased 4 pounds to 252.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.33 billion pounds was up 4 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.59 million head, up 4 percent. The average live weight was the same as last year at 246 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 29.0 million pounds was up 4 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 494 thousand head, up 7 percent. The average live weight decreased 1 pound to 118.
