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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in September 1989 totaled 3.32 billion pounds, down 4 percent from September 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-September red meat production, at 29.3 billion pounds, was down 1 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1988 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 3; veal, down 10; pork up 3; lamb and mutton, up 2. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for September 1989 included 21 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays. Kill days for September 1988 consisted of 22 weekdays (one holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING SEPTEMBER 1989 WITH SEPTEMBER 1988

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.91 billion pounds was down 6 percent. Head kill totaled 2.77 million, down 8 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 20 pounds to 1,150.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 28.0 million pounds was down 15 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 179 thousand head, down 17 percent, and the average live weight increased 2 pounds to 261.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.35 billion pounds was down 1 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.68 million head, down 1 percent. The average live weight decreased 1 pound to 246.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 28.0 million pounds was the same as last year. Slaughter totaled 457 thousand head, down 3 percent. The average live weight decreased 1 pound to 120. Offsetting was an increase in average dressing percent.
