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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in October 1989 totaled 3.52 billion pounds, nearly the same as October 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-October red meat production, at 32.8 billions pounds, was down 1 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1989 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, down 10; pork up 2; lamb and mutton, up 3. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for October 1989 included 22 weekdays (one holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for October 1988 consisted of 22 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays.

COMPARING OCTOBER 1989 WITH OCTOBER 1988

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.04 billion pounds was up 2 percent. Head kill totaled 2.96 million, nearly the same as last year. The average live weight increased 16 pounds to 1151.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 31 million pounds was down 9 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 198 thousand head, down 4 percent, and the average live weight decreased 9 pounds to 265.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.42 billion pounds was down 2 percent. Hog kill totaled 8.03 million head, down 1 percent. The average live weight decreased 2 pound to 248.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 30 million pounds was up 7 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 484 thousand head, up 7 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 123.
