**COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION** for the United States in November 1989 totaled 3.41 billion pounds, slightly above November 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-November red meat production, at 36.2 billion pounds, was nearly the same as last year. Percentage changes for 1989 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, down 10; pork up 2; lamb and mutton, up 4. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for November 1989 included 22 weekdays (two holidays) and four Saturdays. Kill days for November 1988 consisted of 22 weekdays (two holidays) and four Saturdays.

## COMPARING NOVEMBER 1989 WITH NOVEMBER 1988

**BEEF PRODUCTION**, at 1.91 billion pounds was up 2 percent. Head kill totaled 2.78 million, down 1 percent. The average live weight increased 19 pounds to 1153.

**VEAL PRODUCTION**, at 28.0 million pounds was down 15 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 182 thousand head, down 13 percent and the average live weight decreased 6 pounds to 256.

**PORK PRODUCTION**, at 1.45 billion pounds was down 1 percent. Hog kill totaled 8.04 million head, down 1 percent. The average live weight decreased 1 pound to 251.

**LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION**, at 31.0 million pounds was up 15 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 482 thousand head, up 11 percent. The average live weight increased 4 pounds to 127.
