**COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION** for the United States in December 1989 totaled 3.17 billion pounds, down 6 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-December red meat production, at 39.4 billion pounds, was down 1 percent from the previous year. Percentage changes for 1989 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, down 11; pork, up 1; lamb and mutton, up 4. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for December 1989 included 21 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays. Kill days for December 1988 consisted of 22 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays.

## COMPARING DECEMBER 1989 WITH DECEMBER 1988

**BEEF PRODUCTION**, at 1.83 billion pounds was down 2 percent. Head kill totaled 2.68 million, down 3 percent. The average live weight increased 10 pounds to 1151.

**VEAL PRODUCTION**, at 25 million pounds was down 22 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 172 thousand head, down 18 percent, and the average live weight decreased 12 pounds to 243.

**PORK PRODUCTION**, at 1.29 billion pounds was down 10 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.24 million head, down 9 percent. The average live weight decreased 2 pounds to 249.

**LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION**, at 31 million pounds was up 7 percent. Slaughter totaled 470 thousand head, up 2 percent. The average live weight increased 3 pounds to 128.
