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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in June 1990 totaled 3.17 billion pounds, down 5 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-June red meat production, at 19.1 billion pounds was down 2 percent from last year. Percentage changes for 1990 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 1; veal, down 13; pork, down 3; lamb and mutton, up 8. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for June 1990 included 21 weekdays and five Saturdays. Kill days for June 1989 consisted of 22 weekdays and four Saturdays.

COMPARING JUNE 1990 WITH JUNE 1989

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.98 billion pounds was down 2 percent. Head kill totaled 2.93 million, down 3 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 1117.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 25.0 million pounds was down 14 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 137 thousand head, down 18 percent, and the average live weight increased 8 pounds to 291.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.14 billion pounds was down 10 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.32 million head, down 11 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 252.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 28.0 million pounds was up 8 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 440 thousand head, up 1 percent. The average live weight increased 6 pounds to 125.
