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**COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION** for the United States in July 1990 totaled 3.10 billion pounds, up 2 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-July red meat production, at 22.2 billion pounds was down 1 percent from last year. Percentage changes for 1990 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down slightly; veal, down 12; pork, down 3; lamb and mutton, up 8. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for July 1990 included 22 weekdays (one holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for July 1989 consisted of 21 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays.

## COMPARING JULY 1990 WITH JULY 1989

**BEEF PRODUCTION**, at 1.94 billion pounds was up 3 percent. Head kill totaled 2.85 million, up 2 percent. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 1,125.

**VEAL PRODUCTION**, at 26.0 million pounds was down 4 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 144 thousand head, down 17 percent. The average live weight increased 26 pounds to 284.

**PORK PRODUCTION**, at 1.10 billion pounds was down 1 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.15 million head, down 2 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 3 pounds to 249.

**LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION**, at 28.0 million pounds was up 12 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 447 thousand head, up 8 percent. The average live weight increased 3 pounds to 122.
