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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in August 1990 totaled 3.43 billion pounds, down 2 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-August red meat production, at 25.6 billion pounds was down 1 percent from last year. Percentage changes for 1990 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down slightly; veal, down 11; pork, down 3; lamb and mutton, up 7. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for August 1990 included 23 weekdays and four Saturdays. Kill days for August 1989 consisted of 23 weekdays and four Saturdays.

COMPARING AUGUST 1990 WITH AUGUST 1989

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.06 billion pounds was down 1 percent. Head kill totaled 2.98 million, down 2 percent. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 1,144.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 28.0 million pounds was down 3 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 152 thousand head, down 22 percent, and the average live weight increased 39 pounds to 291.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.31 billion pounds was down 2 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.30 million head, down 4 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 248.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 30.0 million pounds was up 3 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 482 thousand head, down 2 percent. The average live weight increased 4 pounds to 122.
