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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in September 1990, totaled 3.09 billion pounds, down 7 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-September red meat production, at 28.7 billion pounds was down 2 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1990 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 1; veal, down 11; pork, down 4; lamb and mutton, up 6. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for September 1990 contained 20 weekdays (including one holiday) and five Saturdays. Kill days for September 1989 consisted of 21 weekdays (including one holiday) and five Saturdays.

COMPARING SEPTEMBER 1990 WITH SEPTEMBER 1989

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.81 billion pounds was down 5 percent. Head kill totaled 2.61 million, down 6 percent. The average live weight decreased 4 pounds to 1,146.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 26.0 million pounds was down 7 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 138 thousand head, down 23 percent, and the average live weight increased 34 pounds to 295.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.23 billion pounds was down 9 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.90 million head, down 10 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 247.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 27.0 million pounds was unchanged from last year. Slaughter totaled 439 thousand head, down 4 percent. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 122.
