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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in October 1990 totaled 3.49 billion pounds, down 1 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-October red meat production, at 32.2 billion pounds was down 2 percent from last year. Percentage changes for 1990 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 1; veal, down 10; pork, down 3; lamb and mutton, up 6. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for October 1990 contained 23 weekdays(including one holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for October 1989 contained 22 weekdays(including one holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING OCTOBER 1990 WITH OCTOBER 1989

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.04 billion pounds, was up fractionally. Head kill totaled 2.96 million, down slightly. The average live weight decreased 3 pounds to 1,149.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 31.0 million pounds, was unchanged. Calf slaughter totaled 162 thousand head, down 29 percent, and the average live weight increased 36 pounds to 301.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.39 billion pounds, was down 2 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.74 million head, down 4 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 249.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 32.0 million pounds, was up 7 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 507 thousand head, up 5 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 124.
