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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in November 1990 totaled 3.28 billion pounds, down 4 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-November red meat production, at 35.5 billion pounds was down 2 percent from last year. Percentage changes for 1990 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 1; veal, down 8; pork, down 4 and lamb and mutton, up 5. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days in November 1990 included 22 weekdays (including two holidays) and four Saturdays. Kill days in November 1989 consisted of 22 weekdays (including two holidays) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING NOVEMBER 1990 WITH NOVEMBER 1989

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.84 billion pounds was down 3 percent. Head kill totaled 2.70 million, down 3 percent. The average live weight decreased 9 pounds to 1,144.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 29.0 million pounds was up 4 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 155 thousand head, down 15 percent. The average live weight increased 38 pounds to 294.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.37 billion pounds was down 5 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.54 million head, down 6 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 253.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 30.0 million pounds was down 3 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 481 thousand head, down fractionally. The average live weight decreased 2 pounds to 125.
