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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in December 1990 totaled 3.08 billion pounds, down 3 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-December red meat production, at 38.6 billion pounds was down 2 percent from last year. Percentage changes for 1990 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, down 7; pork, down 3; lamb and mutton, up 5. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for both December 1990 and 1989 contained 21 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays.

COMPARING DECEMBER 1990 WITH DECEMBER 1989

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.68 billion pounds was down 8 percent. Head kill totaled 2.45 million, down 9 percent. The average live weight decreased 6 pounds to 1,145.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 28.0 million pounds was up 12 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 142 thousand head, down 18 percent, and the average live weight increased 64 pounds to 307.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.34 billion pounds was up 4 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.35 million head, up 2 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 3 pounds to 252.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 30.0 million pounds was down 3 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 465 thousand head, down 1 percent. The average live weight decreased 2 pounds to 126.
