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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in January 1991 totaled 3.43 billion pounds, up 2 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

January 1991 and 1990 both contained 23 weekdays (one holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING JANUARY 1991 WITH JANUARY 1990

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.97 billion pounds, was up 2 percent. Head kill totaled 2.88 million, up 1 percent. The average live weight decreased 1 pound to 1,143.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 31.0 million pounds, was up 14 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 154 thousand head, down 14 percent, and the average live weight increased 65 pounds to 317.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.40 billion pounds, was up 2 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.65 million head, up slightly from last year. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 251.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 33.0 million pounds, was up 2 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 508 thousand head, up 4 percent. The average live weight decreased 2 pounds to 127.
