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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in March 1991 totaled 3.08 billion pounds, down 5 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-March red meat production, at 9.46 billion pounds was down 1 percent from last year. Percentage changes for 1991 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, up 5; pork, down fractionally; lamb and mutton, up 6. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

March 1991 contained 21 weekdays and five Saturdays. March 1990 consisted of 22 weekdays and five Saturdays.

COMPARING MARCH 1991 WITH MARCH 1990

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.72 billion pounds was down 8 percent. Head kill totaled 2.51 million, down 9 percent. The average live weight increased 22 pounds to 1,155.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 26.0 million pounds was down 7 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 123 thousand head, down 27 percent, and the average live weight increased 85 pounds to 353.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.30 billion pounds was down 2 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.22 million head, down 3 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 250.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 36.0 million pounds was up 12 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 565 thousand head, up 15 percent. The average live weight decreased 3 pounds to 126.
