LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER, MEAT, AND LARD PRODUCTION 1974

Production of red meat in the United States during 1974 was 9 percent more than in 1973. The 1974 total of 37.9 billion pounds of beef, veal, pork, lamb and mutton includes estimated slaughter on farms in addition to slaughter in commercial plants. Beef production increased 9 percent to 23.1 billion pounds. Veal production jumped 36 percent to 486 million pounds. Pork production was up 8 percent to 13.8 billion pounds. Production of lamb and mutton totaled 465 million pounds, a decrease of 10 percent from the year earlier. In 1974, beef accounted for about 61 percent of the red meat total, pork 37 percent, lamb and mutton 1 percent, and veal 1 percent. Lard production at 1.4 billion pounds, was up 9 percent from 1973.

Commercial cattle slaughter totaled 36.8 million head in 1974 of which 90.5 percent were slaughtered in Federally inspected plants and 9.5 percent in other plants. Calf slaughter totaled 3.0 million head with 78.8 percent slaughtered in Federally inspected plants and 21.2 percent in other plants. The hog slaughter of 81.8 million head consisted of 94.3 percent slaughtered under Federal inspection and 5.7 percent in other plants. Of the 8.8 million sheep and lambs slaughtered in 1974, about 96.7 percent was in Federally inspected plants and 3.3 percent in other plants.

The average live weight of commercial cattle slaughtered in 1974 was 1,039 pounds, down 4 pounds from 1973. For calves slaughtered in 1974, the average live weight was 257 pounds, an increase of 1 pound from the previous year. The average live weight of hog slaughtered was 244 pounds for 1974, up 3 pounds from 1973. Commercial sheep and lamb slaughter averaged 105 pounds, 2 pounds less than 1973.
