LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER, MEAT, AND LARD PRODUCTION 1975

Production of red meat in the United States during 1975 was 3 percent less than 1974. The 1975 total of 36.8 billion pounds of beef, veal, pork, lamb and mutton includes estimated slaughter of farms in addition to slaughter in commercial plants. Beef production increased 4 percent to 24.0 billion pounds. Veal production jumped 80 percent to 873 million pounds. Pork production was down 17 percent to 11.5 billion pounds. Production of lamb and mutton totaled 410 million pounds, a decrease of 12 percent from a year earlier. In 1975, beef accounted for 65.2 percent of the red meat total, pork 31.3 percent, lamb and mutton 1.1 percent, and veal 2.4 percent. Lard production at 1.0 billion pounds was down 26 percent from 1974.

Commercial cattle slaughter totaled 40.9 million head in 1975 of which 90.2 percent were slaughtered in Federally inspected plants and 9.8 percent in other plants. Calf slaughter totaled 5.2 million head with 74.7 percent slaughtered in Federally inspected plants and 25.3 percent in other plants.

Hog slaughter at 68.7 million head consisted of 94.5 percent slaughtered under Federal inspection and 5.5 percent in other plants. Of the 7.8 million sheep and lambs slaughtered in 1975, about 96.4 percent was in Federally inspected plants and 3.6 percent in other plants.

The average live weight of commercial cattle slaughtered in 1975 was 996 pounds, down 43 pounds from 1974. For calves slaughtered in 1975, the average live weight was 283 pounds, an increase of 26 pounds from the previous year. The average live weight of hogs slaughtered was 240 pounds for 1975, down 4 pounds from 1974. Sheep and lambs slaughtered averaged 104 pounds, 1 pound less than 1974.
