LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER, MEAT, AND LARD PRODUCTION 1976

The 1976 total U.S. red meat production was 39.6 billion pounds, up 8 percent from 1975. Production includes beef, veal, pork, lamb and mutton slaughtered in commercial establishments and farm slaughter. Beef production was 26.0 billion pounds - an increase of 8 percent from 1975, and accounted for about two-thirds of the total. There were 853 million pounds of veal produced, 2 percent below the previous year and accounted for 2.2 percent of the 1976 total red meat. Pork yielded 31.3 percent of the total red meats and at 12.4 billion pounds, was up 8 percent from 1975. Lamb and mutton production comprised less than 1.0 percent of the 1976 red meats and the 371 million pounds, was 10 percent below 1975. Lard production rose 5 percent to nearly 1.1 billion pounds.

Commercial cattle slaughter totaled 42.7 million head in 1976 of which 91.4 percent was slaughtered in Federally inspected plants and 8.6 percent in other plants. Calf slaughter totaled 5.4 million head with 83.0 percent slaughtered in Federally inspected plants and 17.0 percent in other plants. Hog kill at 73.8 million head consisted of 95.5 percent killed under Federal inspection and 4.5 percent in other plants. Of the 6.7 million head of sheep and lamb slaughtered, 96.4 percent was in Federally inspected plants and 3.6 percent in other plants.

The average live weight of commercial cattle slaughtered in 1976 was 1,018 pounds, up 22 pounds from 1975. For calves slaughtered in 1976, the average live weight was 267 pounds, down 16 pounds from the previous year. The average live weight of hogs slaughtered was 238 pounds for 1976, down 2 pounds from 1975. Sheep and lambs averaged 109 pounds, up 5 pounds from 1975.
