ANNUAL SUMMARY 1982



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TOTAL SLAUGHTER, MEAT, AND LARD PRODUCTION, 1982

Red meat production for the United States during 1982 totaled 37.6 billion pounds (17.0 million metric tons), down 4 percent from 1981. Production included beef, veal, pork, lamb, and mutton slaughtered in commercial establishments and on farms.

BEEF PRODUCTION was 22.5 billion pounds (10.2 million metric tons), 1 percent above 1981. VEAL PRODUCTION increased 3 percent from 1981 for a total of 448 million pounds (203 thousand metric tons) in 1982. PORK PRODUCTION declined 10 percent to 14.2 billion pounds (6.45 million metric tons). LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION totaled 365 million pounds (166 thousand metric tons), an increase of 8 percent from 1981. Lard production, at 919 million pounds (417 thousand metric tons), was down 21 percent.

Commercial cattle slaughter during 1982 totaled 35.8 million head, up 3 percent from 1981, with Federal inspection comprising 94.6 percent of the total. Calf slaughter, at 3.02 million head, was up 8 percent from last year with 90.4 percent under Federal inspection. Hog slaughter totaled 82.2 million head, a decline of 10 percent from 1981, with Federal inspection comprising 96.5 percent. Commercial sheep and lamb kill increased 7 percent from 1981 to 6.45 million head of which 97.3 percent was in Federally inspected plants.

Average live weight of cattle slaughtered commercially in 1982 was 1064 pounds, down 11 pounds from 1981. For calves slaughtered in 1982, the average live weight was 236 pounds, a decline of 14 pounds from the previous year. The average live weight of hogs, at 243 pounds, was unchanged from 1981. Sheep and lambs averaged 111 pounds live weight, up 1 pound from 1981.
