1/These are not estimates of production but merely averages as calculated by dividing the reported daily milk production of herds kept by crop correspondents by the number of milk cows in these herds. For April 1932 the record includes 22,500 herds and 184,000 cows. For the less important dairy states the numbers reported are not sufficient to provide reliable indications of changes.
