^{1/}These are not estimates of production but merely averages as calculated by dividing the reported daily milk production of herds kept by crop correspondents by the number of milk cows in these herds. For May 1932 the record includes 22,464 herds and 181,436 cows. For the less important dairy states the numbers reported are not sufficient to provide reliable indications of changes.
