1/These are not estimates of production but merely averages as calculated by dividing the reported daily milk production of herds kept by crop correspondents by the number of milk cows in these herds. For June 1932 the record includes 23,002 herds and 186,437 cows. For the less important dairy states the numbers reported are not sufficient to provide reliable indications of changes.
