JANUARY MILK PRODUCTION DOWN 1 PERCENT

Milk production during January is estimated at 9,630 million pounds, down 1 percent from January 1972. Milk output increased 2 percent from December 1972 to January 1973, which is 1 percent less than the increase between these 2 months a year earlier. Milk production in January provided 1.48 pounds of milk per person daily for all uses, slightly less than the 1.50 pounds per person daily in January 1972 but more than the 1.45 pounds in December 1972.

PRODUCTION PER COW UP 1 PERCENT, MILK COWS DOWN 1 PERCENT

January milk production per cow was 830 pounds, up 1 percent from a year ago and 3 percent more than December 1972. The January rate per cow hit record highs in 23 of the 33 States with monthly estimates. California led--1,035 pounds, followed by: Washington, 990 pounds; Colorado, 975 pounds and Utah, 930 pounds.

Milk cows on farms during January totaled 11,606,000, down 1 percent from January 1972.

MILK FEED PRICE RATIO DOWN SHARPLY FROM LAST YEAR

The January milk feed price ratio, at 1.54, was 17 percent less than a year ago. The decrease resulted from a 93-cent increase in ration value while the price of all milk increased 39 cents. The ratio decreased 5 percent from December compared with no change between these same months last year. On a regional basis the January ratio was highest in the West North Central and lowest in the North Atlantic.

MILK COWS AND MILK PRODUCTION - 1972

Total milk production was 120.3 billion pounds in 1972, 1.5 percent more than the revised estimate of 118.5 billion pounds produced in 1971. The annual average number of milk cows on farms in 1972 was a record low--11,710,000, down 1 percent from 11,842,000 in 1971. Output per cow reached a record high, 10,271

pounds in 1972, 2.6 percent more than the previous record, 10,009 pounds in 1971. The revised estimates for 1971 and 1972 are based on an annual review of more complete production and utilization data.

Milk production during 1972 was 5 percent below the record 1964 production, 127.0 billion pounds. Wisconsin led milk production with 19.6 billion pounds, followed by: California, 10.4 billion; New York, 10.2 billion; Minnesota, 9.6 billion and Pennsylvania, 7.0 billion pounds. The 10 top milk producing States turned out 64 percent of the total U. S. production in 1972. Of the 10 leaders, five had a higher production and five fell below a year earlier. Milk production was above the previous year during each of the first 10 months of 1972--then dipped slightly below 1971 production for the last 2 months of the year. The largest increase was 5 percent in February, but the extra day due to leap year added 3.6 percent to the monthly production.

Rate per cow was above a year ago in all but seven States. California cows produced the most, 13,406 pounds per cow. Next came Arizona, 12,800 pounds; Washington, 12,538 pounds and Colorado, 11,633 pounds. A total of 27 States had rates of over 10,000 pounds of milk per cow.

All milk cows on farms was a record low averaging 11,710,000 in 1972, down 1 percent from 11,842,000 in 1971. Milk cow numbers have declined each year since 1953 but the rate of decline has been slowing in recent years.

Revision of Estimates: The 1965-69 estimates of milk cows on farms, milk per cow, total milk production, disposition and income, and number of milk cow farms were revised based on a review of survey information, the 1969 Census of Agriculture and other data which have become available since the original estimates were made. Revised estimates by States for the years 1965-69 are shown in Statistical Bulletin No. 509. This bulletin is now available on request.
