## JANUARY MILK PRODUCTION SLIGHTLY ABOVE A YEAR AGO

Milk production during January is estimated at 9,301 million pounds, slightly above a year earlier. Milk output increased 2.4 percent from December 1974 to January 1975 compared with a 2.6 percent increase between the same months a year ago. Milk production in January provided 1.41 pounds of milk per person daily for all uses. This compares with 1.42 pounds per person a year earlier and 1.38 for December 1974.

## PRODUCTION PER COW UP 6 POUNDS, MILK COWS DOWN 1 PERCENT

January milk production per cow was 830 pounds, up 6 pounds from a year earlier and 9 pounds above January 1973.

Milk cows on farms during January totaled 11,204,000 head, down 1 percent from January 1974.

## JANUARY MILK-FEED PRICE RATIO

The January milk-feed price ratio was up from December in all regions and up 4 percent nationally. However, the ratio was 16 percent below a year ago. The January milk price was above last month in all regions except the South Central States, while the value of rations fed milk cows was below the previous month in all areas.

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MILK COWS AND MILK PRODUCTION - 1974

Total milk production was 115,416 million pounds, practically unchanged from the revised estimate of 115,385 million pounds produced in 1973. Milk produced during 1974 was 9 percent below the record 1964 production of 126,967 million pounds. The annual average number of milk cows on farms was a record low 11,221,000 head, down 1.6 percent from the 1973 average. However, the January-December decrease in cow numbers was 0.5 percent, the smallest decline since 1953 when milk cows actually increased throughout the year. Output per cow during 1974 was 10,286 pounds, 1.7 percent above 1973. Output per cow in 1973 marked the first time since 1944 that production per cow had been below the previous year.

Wisconsin was the leading milk producing State in 1974 with 18.4 billion pounds, followed by: California, 10.6 billion; New York, 9.8 billion; Minnesota, 9.4 billion; and Pennsylvania 7.0 billion pounds. Together, these five States turned out 48 percent of the U. S. production during 1974. The top 10 milk producing States accounted for 64 percent of the national total.

The revised estimates for 1973 and 1974 are based on an annual review of more complete production and utilization data, and results of first-of-year cattle inventory surveys.
