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JANUARY MILK PRODUCTION UP 1.8 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

January milk production is estimated at 9,545 million pounds, up 1.8 percent from a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January output exceeds the December 1975 total by 2.8 percent.

MILK COWS DOWN 1.1 PERCENT, PRODUCTION PER COW UP

The number of milk cows totaled 11,079,000 head during January, down 1.1 percent from a year earlier and 1.7 percent from January 1974. The estimated number of milk cows is 12,000 head below a month earlier.

January production per cow averaged 862 pounds, 25 pounds more than a year ago, and 34 pounds above January 1974.

MILK-FEED PRICE RATIO BELOW LAST MONTH, ABOVE LAST YEAR

The January milk-feed price ratio, at 1.75, was 3 percent below the December 1975 ratio, but well above the January 1975 ratio of 1.25. The average price of milk sold to plants was 10 cents per cwt. below the previous month while the average value of grain and other concentrates fed milk cows registered a 13-cent per cwt. increase.

MILK COWS AND MILK PRODUCTION - 1975

Total 1975 milk production was 115,458 million pounds, down slightly from the revised estimate of 115,553 million pounds produced in 1974. The annual average number of milk cows was 11,151,000 head, 0.6 percent below the 1974 average of 11,219,000 head. Output per cow in 1975 was 10,354 pounds, up 54 pounds from 1974.

Wisconsin was the leading milk producing State in 1975 with 18.90 billion pounds, followed by: California, 10.85 billion; New York, 9.90 billion; Minnesota, 8.95 billion; and Pennsylvania, 7.14 billion pounds. These five States turned out 48 percent of the total U. S. production during 1975. The top 10 milk producing States accounted for 65 percent of the national total.

The revised estimates for 1974 and the 1975 estimates are based on an annual review of production and utilization data and results of first-of-year cattle inventory surveys.
