JANUARY MILK PRODUCTION 3 PERCENT ABOVE PREVIOUS YEAR

January milk production totaled 10.3 billion pounds compared with 10.0 billion pounds for January 1979. Production per cow averaged 951 pounds, up 28 pounds from a year earlier and 38 pounds from January 1978. Total milk cows averaged 10.8 million head, slightly below last year.

1979 MILK PRODUCTION UP 2 PERCENT

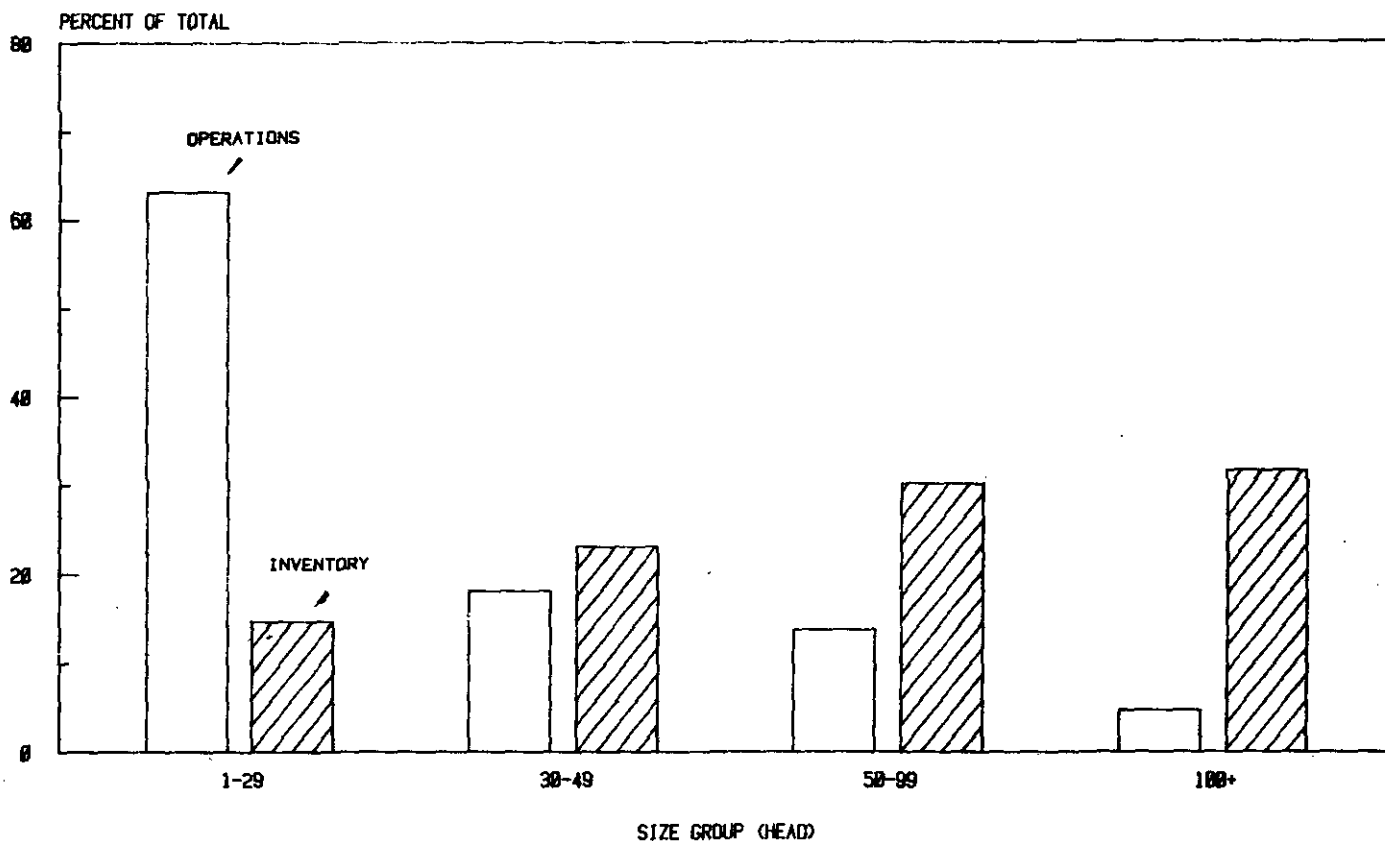
Milk production during 1979 totaled 124 billion pounds, 2 percent above the 1978 estimate of 122 billion pounds. The 1979 production was 3 percent below the record 1964 total of 127 billion pounds. Output per cow in 1979 was a record 11,471 pounds, up 253 pounds from 1978. The annual average number of cows was 10.8 million head, 1 percent below the 1978 average, and continues the long downward trend.

Wisconsin continued as the leading milk producer in 1979 with 22.0 billion pounds, followed by: California, 12.5 billion; New York, 10.7 billion; Minnesota, 9.15 billion; and Pennsylvania, 8.08 billion pounds. These five States turned out over one-half of the U.S. production during 1979.

MILK COW OPERATIONS AND INVENTORY BY SIZE GROUPS

An estimated 4.8 percent of the U.S. operations with milk cows had 100 or more head and accounted for 31.8 percent of the 1979 total milk cow inventory. Operations with 50-99 head represented 13.8 percent of the total operations and held 30.2 percent of the cows. Those operations with 30-49 head accounted for 18.2 percent of all operations and had 23.2 percent of the total milk cows. The balance of the operations had from 1-29 head. These operations represent 63.2 percent of all operations and were holding 14.8 percent of the milk cow inventory.
