

MILK PRODUCTION

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JUNE MILK PRODUCTION 4 PERCENT ABOVE LAST YEAR

Milk production during June totaled 11.4 billion pounds, 4 percent more than June 1979. Accumulated production for the first half of 1980 was 65.0 billion pounds, 4 percent above the first half of 1979.

Production per cow averaged 1055 pounds, 33 pounds above a year earlier and 51 pounds more than June 1978.

Total milk cows averaged 10.8 million head, 1 percent above a year ago and virtually the same as June 1978.

MORE GRAIN AND OTHER CONCENTRATES FED

Grain and other concentrates fed to milk cows on July 1, 1980 averaged 15.2 pounds, 0.7 pound more than a year ago and 1.6 pounds above July 1, 1978.

PRICE OF GRAINS AND OTHER CONCENTRATES HIGHER

The cost of grains and other concentrates fed to milk cows on July 1, 1980 averaged \$7.10 per cwt, 41 cents more than a year earlier and 97 cents above July 1, 1978.

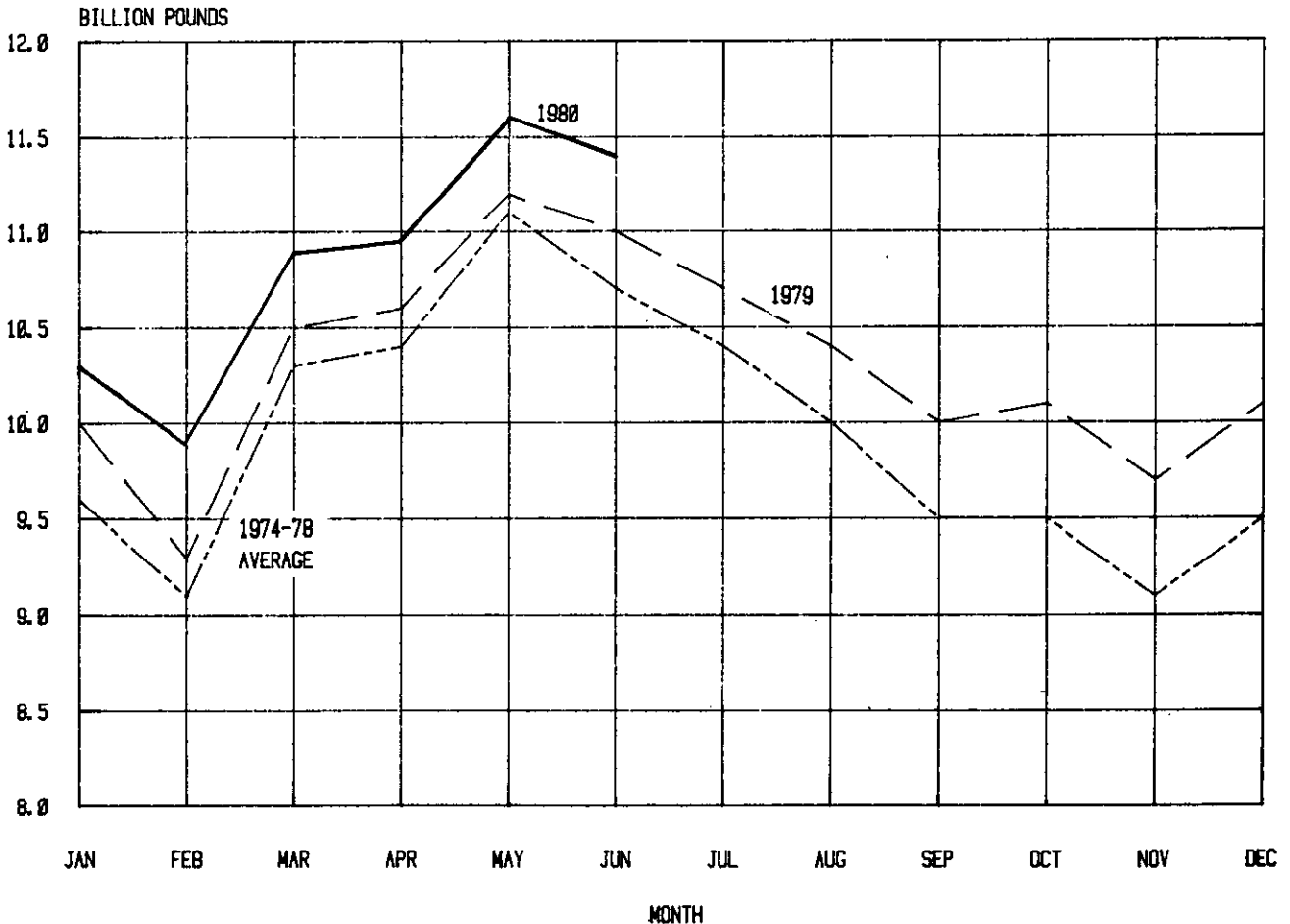

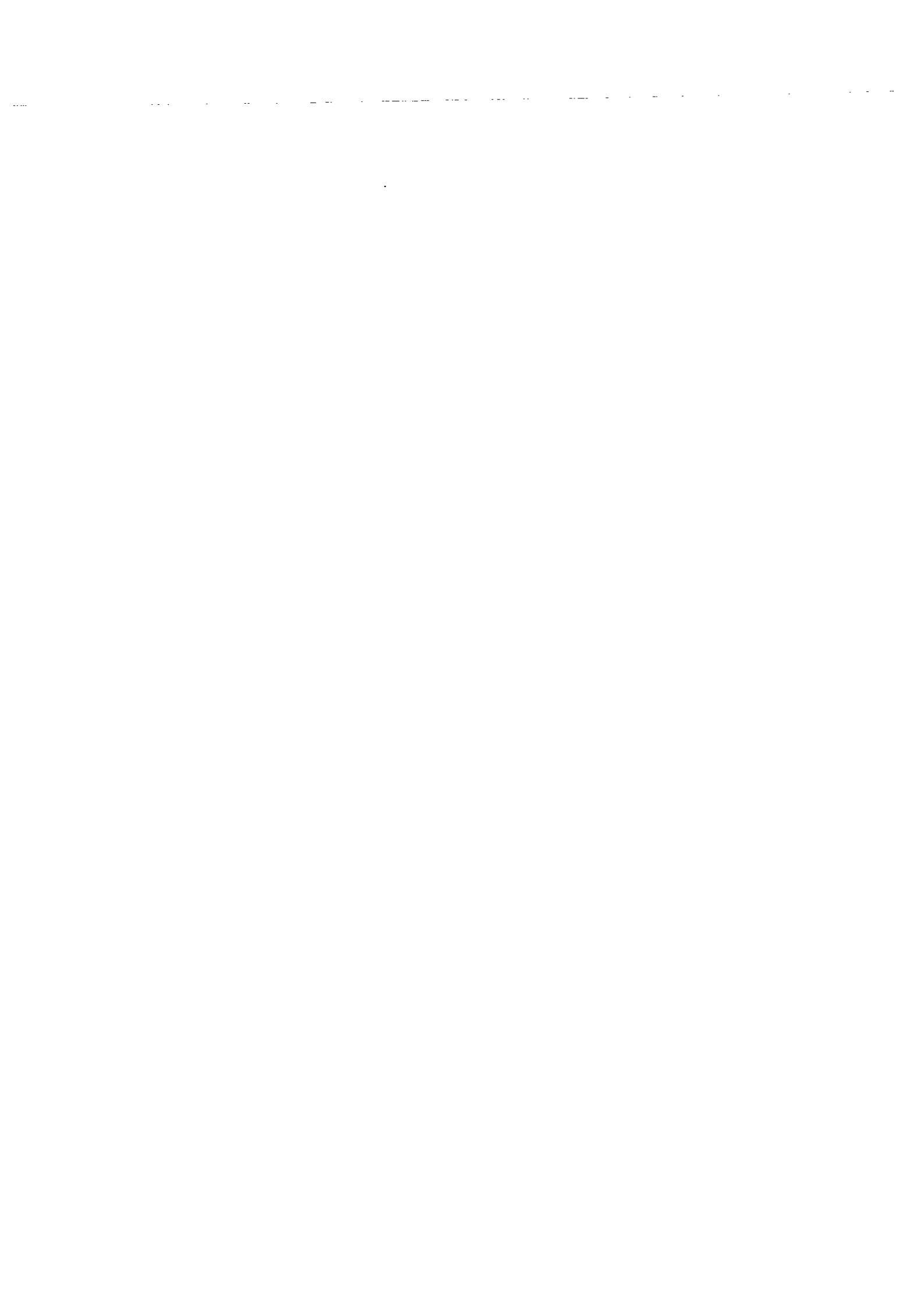
