

MILK PRODUCTION

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JUNE MILK PRODUCTION 3 PERCENT ABOVE LAST YEAR

Milk production during June totaled 11.6 billion pounds, (5.27 million metric tons), 3 percent more than June 1980.

Accumulated milk production for the first half of 1981 totaled 67.5 billion pounds (30.6 million metric tons), compared with 65.2 billion pounds, (29.6 million metric tons), during the first half of 1980.

Production per cow averaged 1069 pounds, 21 pounds above a year earlier and 46 pounds more than June 1979.

Total milk cows averaged 10.9 million head, 1 percent above a year ago, and 2 percent above June 1979.

MORE GRAIN AND OTHER CONCENTRATES FED

Grain and other concentrates fed to milk cows on July 1, 1981 averaged 15.3 pounds, 0.1 pound and 0.8 pound more than July 1, 1980 and July 1, 1979, respectively.

PRICE OF GRAINS AND OTHER CONCENTRATES HIGHER

The cost of grains and other concentrates fed to milk cows on July 1, 1981 averaged \$8.21 per cwt, \$1.11 more than a year earlier and \$1.52 above July 1, 1979.

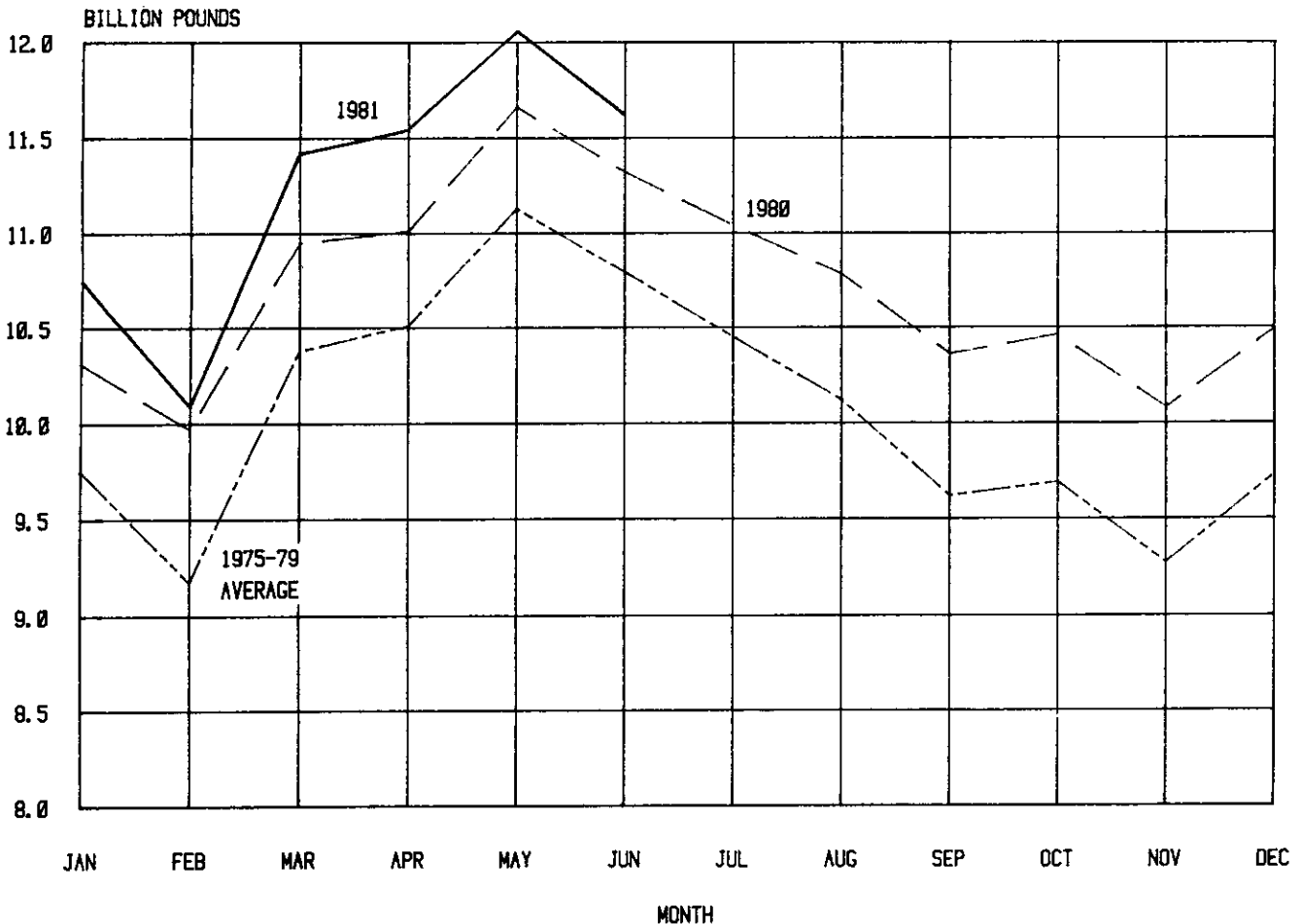
