

# MILK PRODUCTION

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## JANUARY MILK PRODUCTION 2 PERCENT ABOVE PREVIOUS YEAR

Milk production during January 1982 totaled 11.0 billion pounds, (5.01 million metric tons), 2 percent more than January 1981.

January production per cow averaged 1003 pounds, 11 pounds more than a year earlier and 45 pounds above January 1980.

Total milk cows averaged 11.0 million head, 1 percent more than a year earlier and 2 percent above January 1980.

## 1981 MILK PRODUCTION A RECORD HIGH

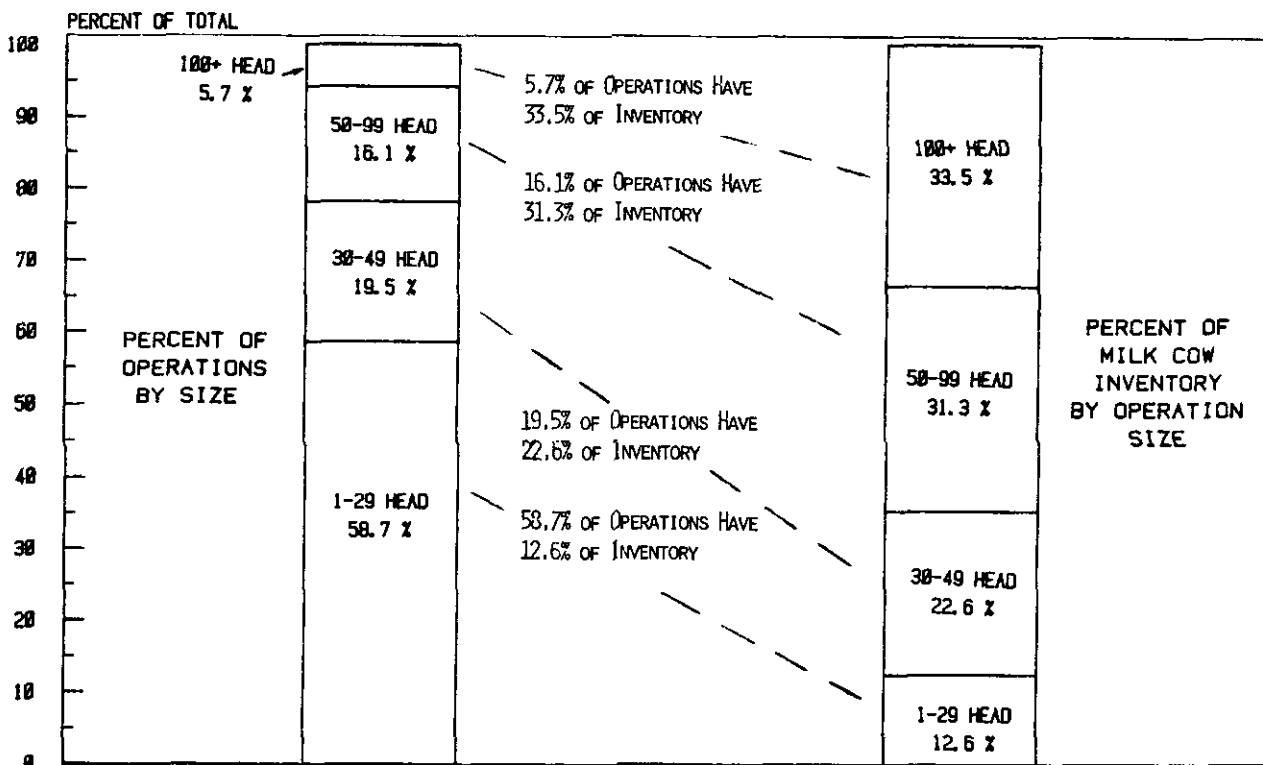
Milk production during 1981 totaled a record high 133 billion pounds, (60.2 million metric tons), 3 percent more than the previous record high of 129 billion pounds (58.3 million metric tons) set in 1980. Output per cow in 1981 was also a record high, at 12,147 pounds, 258 pounds above the previous record set during 1980. The annual average number of cows was 10.9 million head, 1 percent above the 1980 average of 10.8 million head.

Wisconsin remained the leading milk producer in 1981 with 22.7 billion pounds, followed by: California, 14.2 billion; New York, 11.1 billion; Minnesota, 10.1 billion; and Pennsylvania 8.97 billion pounds. These five States continue to produce over one-half of the U.S. output.

## MILK COW OPERATIONS AND INVENTORY BY SIZE GROUPS

An estimated 5.7 percent of the U.S. operations with milk cows had 100 or more head and accounted for 33.5 percent of the 1981 total milk cow inventory. Operations with 50-99 head represented 16.1 percent of the total operations and held 31.3 percent of the cows. Those operations with 30-49 head accounted for 19.5 percent of all operations and had 22.6 percent of the total milk cows. The balance of the operations had from 1-29 head representing 58.7 percent of all operations and were holding 12.6 percent of the milk cow inventory.
