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JUNE MILK PRODUCTION TOTALED 12.0 BILLION POUNDS

Milk production during June totaled 12.0 billion pounds (5.46 million metric tons), 4 percent less than May 1983 but 4 percent more than June 1981. Comparative data for 1982 are not available by months but will be published on a quarterly basis in this issue, October 1983, and January 1984 issues of Milk Production.

Accumulated milk production during the first six months of 1983 totaled 70.4 billion pounds (31.9 million metric tons), up 2 percent from the same period in 1982, and 4 percent above the 1981 period.

Production per cow averaged 1087 pounds during June 1983, 42 pounds below the May output but 23 pounds above June 1981.

The total number of milk cows averaged 11.1 million head during June, up slightly from May and 2 percent above June 1981.

GRAINS AND OTHER CONCENTRATES FED

Grain and other concentrates fed to milk cows on July 1, 1983 averaged 15.7 pounds, up 0.1 pound from July 1, 1982 and up 0.3 pound from July 1, 1981.

VALUE OF GRAINS AND CONCENTRATES

The value of grains and other concentrates fed to milk cows on July 1, 1983 averaged \$7.81 per hundredweight, \$.19 above a year earlier but \$.36 below July 1, 1981.

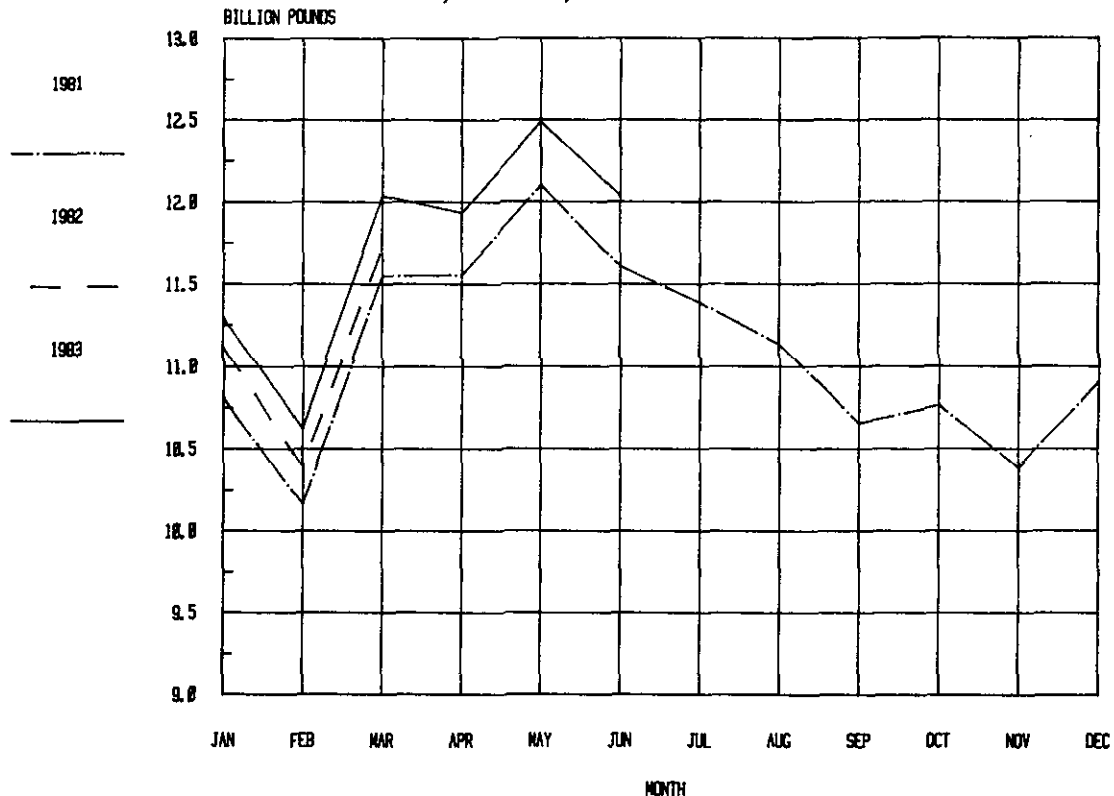
