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JUNE MILK PRODUCTION TOTALED 11.8 BILLION POUNDS

Milk production during June totaled 11.8 billion pounds (5.37 million metric tons), 4 percent below June 1983.

Accumulated milk production during the second quarter of 1984 totaled 35.8 billion pounds (16.2 million metric tons), 3 percent below the comparable period in 1983.

Production per cow averaged 1091 pounds during June, 13 pounds below June 1983.

The total number of milk cows averaged 10.8 million head during June, 3 thousand less than the May average.

GRAIN AND OTHER CONCENTRATES FED

Grain and other concentrates fed to milk cows on July 1, 1984 averaged 14.9 pounds, down 0.8 pound from July 1, 1983.

VALUE OF GRAIN AND OTHER CONCENTRATES

The value of grain and other concentrates fed to milk cows on July 1, 1984 averaged \$8.46 per hundredweight, 66 cents above July 1, 1983.

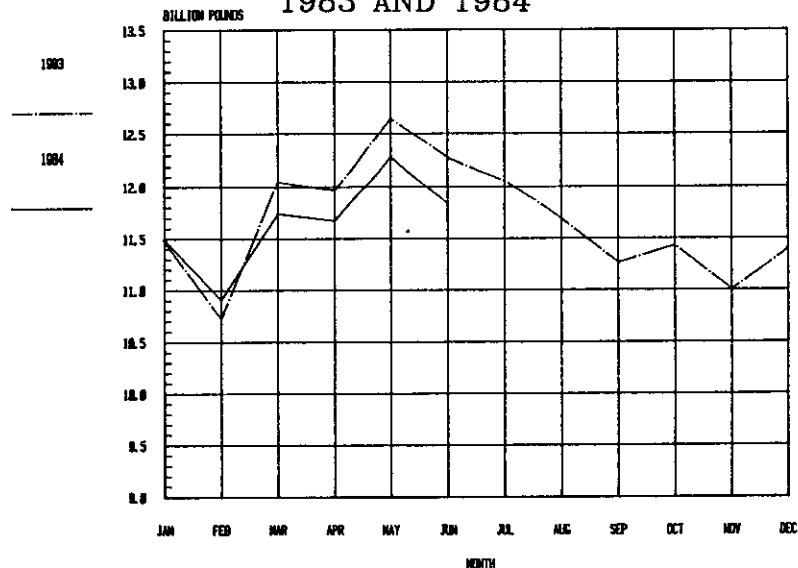
