## OCTOBER MILK PRODUCTION TOTALED 10.9 BILLION POUNDS

Milk production during October 1984 totaled 10.9 billion pounds (4.96 million metric tons), down 4 percent from October 1983.

Accumulated milk production during the first ten months of 1984 totaled 115 billion pounds (51.9 million metric tons), down 3 percent from the same period in 1983.

Production per cow averaged 1010 pounds during October 1984, 14 pounds below October 1983.

The total number of milk cows averaged 10.8 million head during October, 3 percent below October 1983.

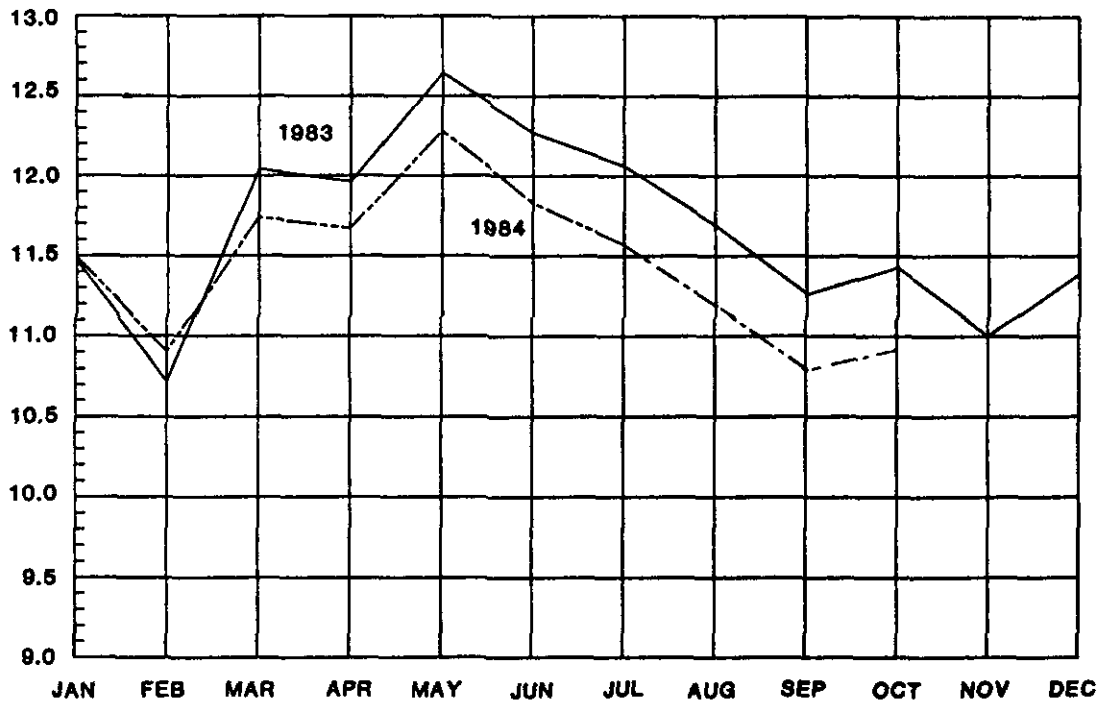
