
Milk Production



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JANUARY MILK PRODUCTION TOTALED 11.2 BILLION POUNDS

Milk production during January 1985 totaled 11.2 billion pounds, (5.08 million metric tons), 1 percent below January 1984.

January production per cow averaged 1038 pounds, 6 pounds above a year earlier.

Total milk cows averaged 10.8 million head, 2 percent below January 1984.

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1984 MILK PRODUCTION SUMMARY

Milk production during 1984 totaled 135 billion pounds (61.4 million metric tons), 3 percent below the record high of 140 billion pounds (63.4 million metric tons) set in 1983. Output per cow in 1984, at 12.5 thousand pounds, is 90 pounds below 1983. The annual average number of cows is 10.8 million head, 2 percent below the 1983 average of 11.1 million head.

Wisconsin, with 23.5 billion pounds, remained the leading milk producer in 1984 followed by: California, 15.3 billion; New York, 11.4 billion; Minnesota, 10.3 billion; and Pennsylvania, 9.42 billion pounds. These five States produce over one-half of the U.S. milk.

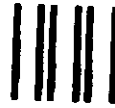




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
