MAY MILK PRODUCTION TOTALED 12.8 BILLION POUNDS

Milk production during May 1985 totaled 12.8 billion pounds, (5.80 million metric tons), 5 percent more than May 1984.

Accumulated milk production for the first five months totaled 58.4 billion pounds (26.5 million metric tons), 1 percent more than the comparable period in 1984.

Production per cow averaged 1164 pounds, 32 pounds more than May 1984.

The average number of milk cows in herds averaged 11.0 million head during May 1985, 2 percent more than the May 1984 average, and 1 percent more than April 1985.

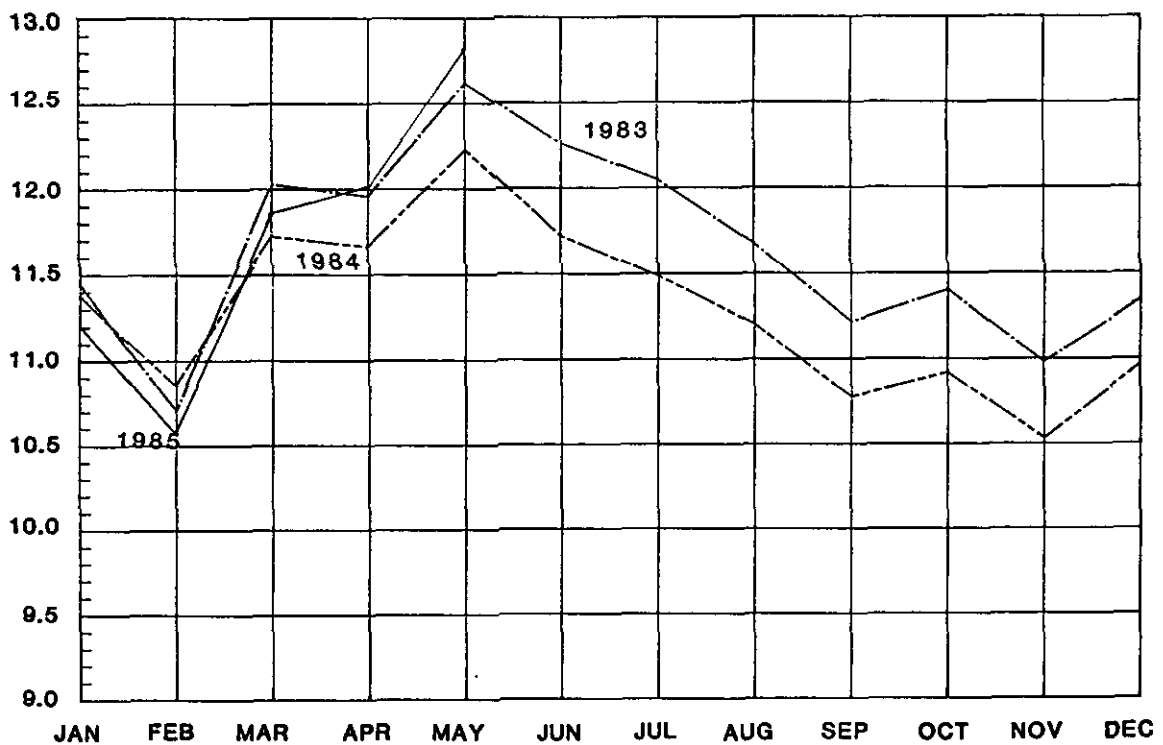
