JULY MILK PRODUCTION TOTALED 12.4 BILLION POUNDS

Milk production during July 1985 totaled 12.4 billion pounds (5.63 million metric tons), --a record high July production-- and 8 percent above July 1984.

Accumulated milk production during the first seven months of 1985 totaled 83.3 billion pounds (37.8 million metric tons), up 3 percent from the same period in 1984.

Production per cow averaged 1120 pounds during July 1985, 56 pounds above July 1984.

The total number of milk cows averaged 11.1 million head during July, 3 percent above a year earlier.

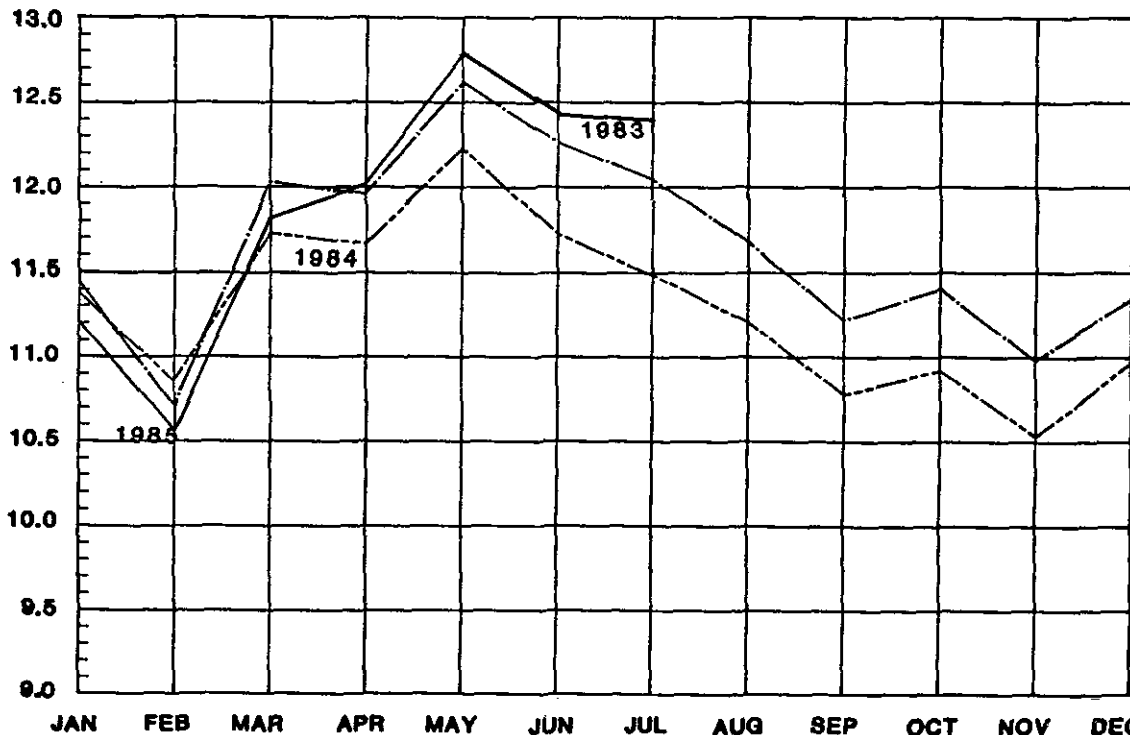
