
Milk Production



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JANUARY MILK PRODUCTION TOTALED 12.2 BILLION POUNDS

January Milk Production was a record high at 12.2 billion pounds (5.52 million metric tons). This was 8 percent more than the January 1985 production and was 6 percent above the previous January record set in 1983.

January production per cow averaged 1091 pounds, 47 pounds above a year earlier.

During January total milk cows averaged 11.2 million head, 3 percent above the same month in 1985 but was 22 thousand head less than December 1985.

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1985 MILK PRODUCTION SUMMARY

Milk production during 1985 totaled a record high 144 billion pounds (65.2 million metric tons), 3 percent above the previous record high of 140 billion pounds (63.4 million metric tons) set in 1983. Output per cow in 1985, at 13.0 thousand pounds, is 525 pounds above 1984. The annual average number of cows is 11.0 million head, 2 percent above the 1984 average of 10.8 million head.

Wisconsin, with 25.1 billion pounds, remained the leading milk producer in 1985 followed by: California, 16.7 billion; New York, 11.7 billion; Minnesota, 10.8 billion; and Pennsylvania, 9.98 billion pounds. These five States produced over one-half of the U.S. milk.
