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JULY MILK PRODUCTION (21 STATES)

Milk production in the 21 selected States totaled 10.5 billion pounds (4.78 million metric tons). This was 1 percent less than production in these same States for July 1985.

During the April-June period the 21 selected States produced 84.8 percent of the U.S. production. If producers in the 29 States not surveyed for August 1, followed the trend shown by the reporting States, the U.S. milk production would total about 12.4 billion pounds (5.64 million metric tons) for July.

Production per cow in the 21 selected States averaged 1166 pounds during July, 15 pounds above July 1985.

Milk cows in the 21 selected States averaged 9.05 million head, 1 percent less than June 1986.

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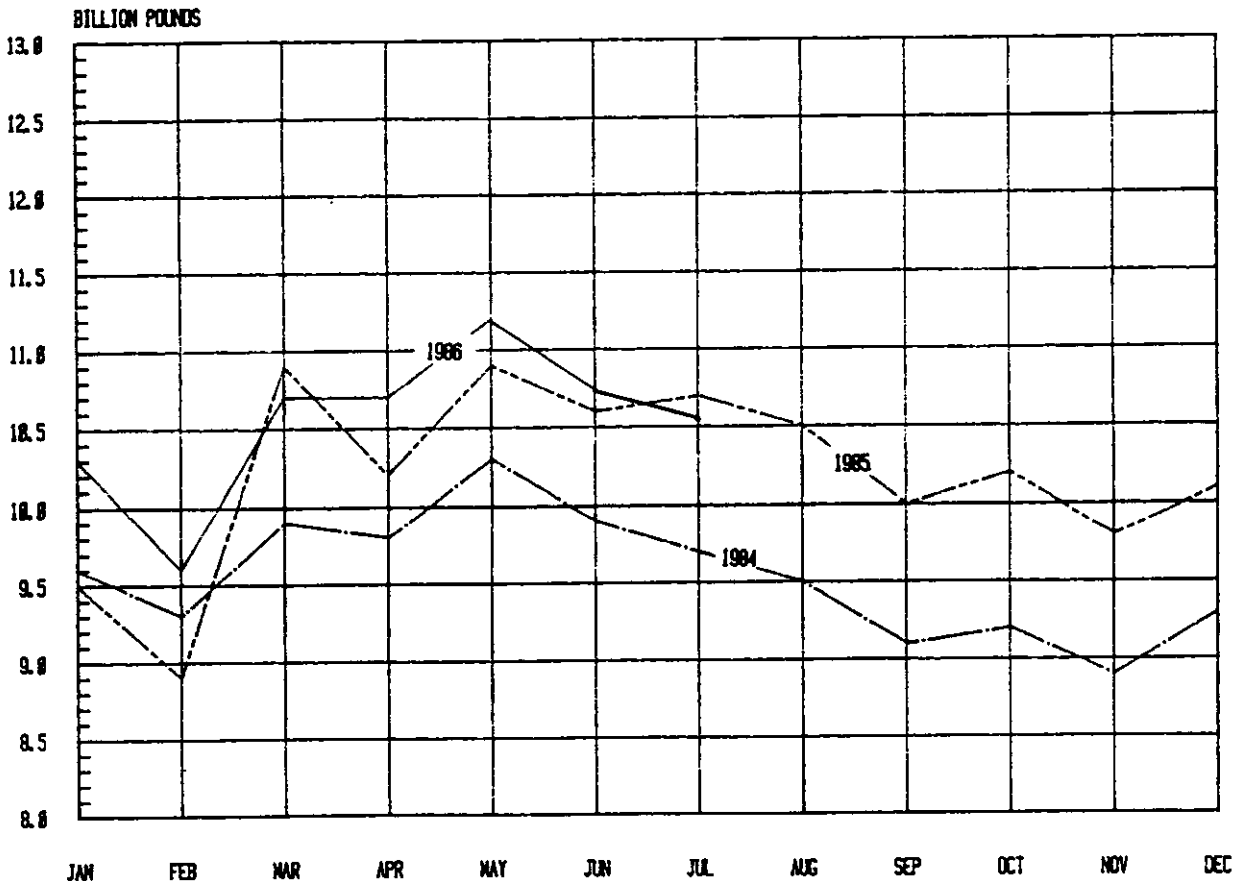
