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NOVEMBER MILK PRODUCTION (21 STATES)

Milk production in the 21 selected States totaled 9.45 billion pounds (4.29 million metric tons). This is 3 percent less than production in these same States for November 1985.

During the July-September period, the 21 selected States produced 85.1 percent of the U.S. production. If the producers in the 29 States not surveyed December 1 followed the same production pattern as the 21 States, the U.S. production would be 11.1 billion pounds (5.04 million metric tons) for November.

Production per cow in the 21 States averaged 1058 pounds during November, 41 pounds less than October 1986 but 10 pounds more than November 1985.

Milk cows in the 21 selected States during November averaged 8.93 million head, 4 percent less than November last year and 26 thousand head less than October 1986.

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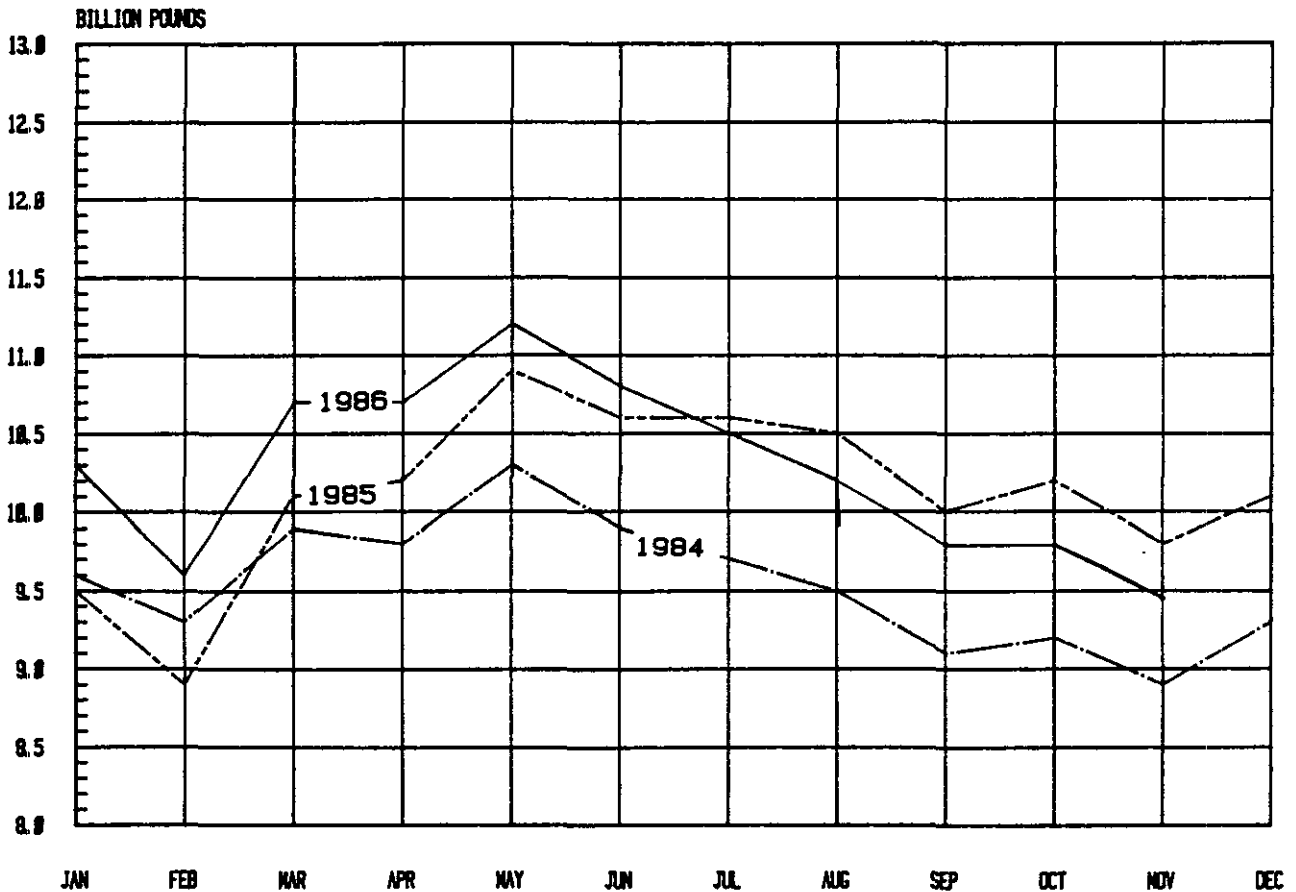
