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JULY MILK PRODUCTION

Milk production in the 21 major States during July totaled 10.3 billion pounds, 2 percent below production in these same States in July 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. June revised production, at 10.4 billion pounds, was 1 percent below June 1988.

Production per cow in the 21 major States averaged 1,213 pounds for July, 9 pounds below July 1988.

The number of cows on farms in the 21 major States was 8.50 million head, 104 thousand head below July 1988 and 4 thousand head below June 1989.

During the April-June period the 21 major States produced 32.3 billion pounds of milk, 85.1 percent of the U.S. production. If producers in the remaining 29 States not surveyed monthly followed the same pattern as the 21 States, the U.S. production would be 12.1 billion pounds for July 1989.
