
Milk Production



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JULY MILK PRODUCTION

Milk production in the 21 major States during July totaled 10.7 billion pounds, 5 percent above production in these same States in July 1989, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. June revised production, at 10.7 billion pounds, was 4 percent above June 1989.

Production per cow in the 21 major States averaged 1,258 pounds for July, 59 pounds more than July 1989.

The number of cows on farms in the 21 major States was 8.51 million head, 4 thousand less than June 1990 but 17 thousand head more than July 1989.

During the April-June period, the 21 major States produced 32.8 billion pounds of milk, 85.0 percent of the U.S. production. If producers in the remaining 29 states not surveyed monthly followed the same pattern as the 21 States, the U.S. production would be 12.6 billion pounds for July 1990.
