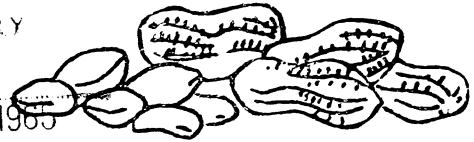

RECORD HIGH COMMERCIAL STOCKS

Peanuts held in off-farm positions on January 31, 1965 totaled 1,456 million pounds of equivalent farmers' stock, according to reports received by the Crop Reporting Board from millers, warehousemen and commercial processors. These stocks were the highest of record for any January 31. Actual farmers' stock made up 855 million pounds of holdings while shelled edibles and unshelled roasting stock accounted for 571 million and 30 million pounds, respectively, when converted to a farmers' stock basis.

The January 31, 1965 stocks of shelled edibles, including CCC holdings, totaled 369 million pounds actual weight. Shelled peanuts held by CCC totaled 25.1 million pounds, compared with 65.7 million pounds a year earlier. The current January 31 CCC holdings were made up of 0.7 million pounds of number 2 Runners and the following Virginias: 5.9 million pounds of extra large, 10.5 million pounds of mediums, 0.5 million number 1, and 7.5 million pounds of quality control grade (Form CCC 1003).

MILLINGS EXCEED LAST SEASON

During January 1965, about 247 million pounds of farmers' stock were milled. This compares with 231 million milled during the previous month and 226 million pounds in January 1964. Millings for the current season, August 1-January 31, totaled 1,190 million pounds -- 392 million Virginias, 364 million Runners, and 434 million of Spanish. In the comparable period of the 1963-64 season, about 1,104 million pounds were milled.

USES AT RECORD HIGH LEVEL

Shelled peanuts used for edible purposes, (excluding oil) totaled 67.7 million pounds (raw weight basis) during January 1965, to bring the season's total to a record 451.2 million pounds. Cumulative uses in edible products for the first six months of this season were as follows: 239.0 million pounds in peanut butter, 9.9 million in peanut butter sandwiches, 110.3 million in salted peanuts, 84.8 million in peanut candy, and 7.2 million pounds in other products.

Shelled peanuts crushed for oil and meal during January totaled 32.9 million pounds, bringing the season's total to 136.3 million. About 107.9 million pounds were crushed during the August-January 31 period of the previous season.

Deliveries of peanut butter under U. S. Government contract for school lunch and food distribution programs for the August 31-January 31 period amounted to 26.1 million pounds.
