February Inventory Above 1966

Peanuts held in commercial facilities on February 28, 1967 totaled 1,432 - million pounds of equivalent farmers stock -- 63 million pounds above the February 28 total a year ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The ending February inventory showed 651 million pounds of actual farmers' stock, roasting stock equivalent to 31 million pounds of farmers' stock, and shelled edibles equal to 750 million pounds of farmers' stock.

Stocks of shelled edibles at the month's end totaled nearly 484 million pounds (actual weight basis) and were 7 percent above the same date last year. These stocks by type show 215 million pounds of Virginias, 133 million pounds of Runners and 135 million pounds of Spanish type nuts. Holdings by CCC included in total stocks of shelled edibles amounted to 94.5 million pounds compared with 41.8 million a year earlier. CCC holdings were made up of 16.2 million pounds of medium Virginias, 6.0 million pounds of sheller run Virginias acquired through custom shelling of Segregation 2 and 3 farmers' stock, and 72.3 million pounds of mixed types acquired under the Sheller Purchase Program.

Cumulative Millings Short of Last Year

Millings of the 1966 crop to date, excluding seed, at 1,639 million pounds are 19 million pounds below the comparable period last year. Millings during February totaled 235 million pounds compared with 224 million pounds during the month last year. By types 83 million pounds of Virginias, 63 million pounds of Runner, and 89 million pounds of Spanish were milled during February.

Raw shelled peanuts used in the production of primary products, excluding oil, totaled 74 million pounds during February. This compares with 71 million pounds used during January and 78 million during February 1966. August 1 - February 28 cumulative usage, at 558 million pounds, is about 2 million pounds below the similar period a year earlier.
