PEANUT STOCKS AND PROCESSING
JULY 31, 1983

These Statistics are collected and presented according to the Peanut Statistics Act which requires shellers, crushers and processors of raw peanuts to submit periodic reports of their operations. These reports are usually based on a complete enumeration of all shellers and crushers and all of the larger processors of raw peanuts. However, because of the number of processors of raw peanuts, reports are occasionally received too late to be included in the first tabulation. Allowances are made for these missing reports and revised totals are published in the next report.

JULY PEANUT STOCKS UP 14 PERCENT

Peanut stocks in commercial storage on July 31, 1983, totaled 864 million pounds of equivalent farmer stock, 14 percent more than the amount on hand a year earlier. This total includes 51.4 million pounds of actual farmer stock compared with 84.9 million pounds on hand a year ago.

Shelled peanuts on hand totaled 741 million pounds of equivalent farmer stock, compared with 626 million pounds on hand a year ago. Roasting stock totaled 71.8 million pounds, up 59 percent from the 45.2 million pounds on hand a year ago. There were no Commodity Credit Corporation uncommitted stock on hand as of July 31, 1983.

Shelled peanut stocks on July 31, 1983 totaled 557 million pounds of which 538 million pounds were edible grades and 19.2 million pounds were oil stock. Edible grade stocks by type were Virginias, 82.4 million pounds; Runners, 399 million pounds; and Spanish, 56.3 million pounds.

MILLINGS DOWN

February 1983-July 1983 millings totaled 1.61 billion pounds, down 3 percent from the same period a year ago. Millings by type were 296 million pounds of Virginias, 1.18 billion pounds of Runners, and 132 million pounds of Spanish.

EDIBLE USES AND CRUSHINGS

Commercial processors utilized 646 million pounds of shelled edible grade peanuts during February-July, compared with 650 million pounds a year earlier. Utilization for peanut butter, at 346 million pounds, was up 1 percent; utilization for peanut candy, at 133 million pounds, was down 1 percent; and utilization for salted peanuts, at 147 million pounds, was down 5 percent.

Crushings for oil, cake, and meal totaled 162 million pounds during the period, down 41 percent from the 274 million pounds crushed a year ago.

Deliveries under the Government's Domestic Feeding and Child Nutrition Programs amounted to 11,457,000 pounds of peanut butter, 2,927,610 pounds of roasted peanuts and 693,000 pounds of peanut granules during the last six months of the marketing year.
