## PEANUT STOCKS AND PROCESSING NOVEMBER 30, 1988

Peanut stocks in commercial storage on November 30, 1988, totaled 3.34 billion pounds of equivalent farmer stock. This total includes 2.69 billion pounds of actual farmer stock.

Shelled peanuts on hand totaled 614 million pounds of equivalent farmer stock. Roasting stock totaled 33.8 million pounds. There were 226 million pounds of Commodity Credit Corporation uncommitted stock on hand as of November 30, 1988.

Shelled peanut stocks on November 30, 1988, totaled 462 million pounds of which 436 million pounds were edible grades and 25.6 million pounds were oil stocks. Edible grade stocks by type were: Virginias, 92.8 million pounds; Runners, 295 million pounds; and Spanish, 48.9 million pounds.

### MILLINGS

November millings totaled 424 million pounds. Millings by type were: 131 million pounds of Virginias, 261 million pounds of Runners, and 31.9 million pounds of Spanish.

### EDIBLE USE AND CRUSHINGS

Commercial processors utilized 130 million pounds of shelled edible grade peanuts during November. Utilization for peanut butter was 64.3 million pounds, utilization for peanut candy was 25.5 million pounds, and utilization for salted peanuts was 35.4 million pounds.

Crushings for oil, cake, and meal totaled 38.9 million pounds during the month.

Deliveries under the Government Domestic Feeding and Child Nutrition Programs amounted to 2,397,206 pounds of peanut butter, 792,000 pounds of roasted peanuts, and 161,700 pounds of peanut granules during the month of November.

### STOCKS OF TREATED SEED

Stocks of treated seed on hand as of November 30, 1988, totaled 652 thousand pounds, compared with 366 thousand pounds on October 31, 1988. Of the November total, 155 thousand pounds were Virginias and Valencias, 248 thousand pounds were Runners, and 248 thousand pounds were Spanish. October stocks of seed included 149 thousand pounds of Virginias and Valencias, 119 thousand pounds of Runners, and 98.0 thousand pounds of Spanish.

These Statistics are collected and presented according to the Peanut Statistics Act which requires shellers, crushers and processors of raw peanuts to submit periodic reports for their operations. These reports are based on a complete enumeration of all shellers and crushers and all of the larger processors of raw peanuts. However, because of the number of processors of raw peanuts, reports are occasionally received too late to be included in the first tabulation. Allowances are made for these missing reports and revised totals are published in the next report.
