PEANUT STOCKS AND PROCESSING DECEMBER 31, 1988

Peanut stocks in commercial storage on December 31, 1988, totaled 3.31 billion pounds of equivalent farmer stock. This total includes 2.58 billion pounds of actual farmer stock.

Shelled peanuts on hand totaled 691 million pounds of equivalent farmer stock. Roasting stock totaled 40.5 million pounds. There were 469 million pounds of Commodity Credit Corporation uncommitted stock on hand as of December 31, 1988.

Shelled peanut stocks on December 31, 1988, totaled 520 million pounds of which 497 million pounds were edible grades and 23.0 million pounds were oil stocks. Edible grade stocks by type were: Virginias, 107 million pounds; Runners, 343 million pounds; and Spanish, 47.3 million pounds.

MILLINGS

December millings totaled 361 million pounds. Millings by type were 98.9 million pounds of Virginias, 242 million pounds of Runners, and 20.1 million pounds of Spanish.

EDIBLE USE AND CRUSHINGS

Commercial processors utilized 126 million pounds of shelled edible grade peanuts during December. Utilization for peanut butter was 65.7 million pounds, utilization for peanut candy was 27.2 million pounds, and utilization for salted peanuts was 28.3 million pounds.

Crushings for oil, cake, and meal totaled 44.2 million pounds during the month.

Deliveries under the Government Domestic Feeding and Child Nutrition Programs amounted to 2,043,673 pounds of peanut butter, 867,600 pounds of roasted peanuts, and 138,600 pounds of peanut granules during the month of December.

STOCKS OF TREATED SEED

Stocks of treated seed on hand as of December 31, 1988, totaled 2.12 million pounds, compared with 652 thousand pounds on November 30, 1988. Of the December total, 1.90 million pounds were Virginias and Valencias, 119 thousand pounds were Runners, and 98.0 thousand pounds were Spanish. November stocks of seed included 155 thousand pounds of Virginias and Valencias, 248 thousand pounds of Runners, and 248 thousand pounds of Spanish.

These Statistics are collected and presented according to the Peanut Statistics Act which requires shellers, crushers and processors of raw peanuts to submit periodic reports for their operations. These reports are based on a complete enumeration of all shellers and crushers and all of the larger processors of raw peanuts. However, because of the number of processors of raw peanuts, reports are occasionally received too late to be included in the first tabulation. Allowances are made for these missing reports and revised totals are published in the next report.
