PEANUT STOCKS AND PROCESSING November 30, 1989

Peanut stocks in commercial storage on November 30, 1989 totaled 3.27 billion pounds of equivalent farmer stock. This total includes 2.63 billion pounds of actual farmer stock.

Shelled peanuts on hand totaled 597 million pounds of equivalent farmer stock. Roasting stock totaled 37.4 million pounds. There were 256 million pounds of Commodity Credit Corporation uncommitted stocks on hand as of November 30, 1989.

Shelled peanut stocks on November 30, 1989 totaled 449 million pounds of which 431 million pounds were edible grades and 17.7 million pounds were oil stocks. Edible grade stocks by type were: Virginias, 101 million pounds; Runners, 284 million pounds; and Spanish, 46.5 million pounds.

MILLINGS

November millings totaled 433 million pounds. Millings by type were 134 million pounds of Virginias, 259 million pounds of Runners, and 39.9 million pounds of Spanish.

EDIBLE USE AND CRUSHINGS

Commercial processors utilized 135 million pounds of SHELLED EDIBLE grade peanuts during November. Utilization for all peanut butter products was 68.8 million pounds, utilization for peanut candy was 24.4 million pounds, and utilization for salted peanuts was 39.0 million pounds. CRUSHINGS for oil, cake, and meal totaled 27.4 million pounds during the month.

Deliveries under the Government Domestic Feeding and Child Nutrition Programs amounted to 7,106,197 pounds of peanut butter, 831,600 pounds of roasted peanuts, and 69,300 pounds of peanut granules during the month of November.

STOCKS OF TREATED SEED

Stocks of treated seed on hand as of November 30, 1989 totaled 2.09 million pounds, compared with 243 thousand pounds on October 31, 1989. Of the November total, 2.03 million pounds were Virginias and Valencias, 42.0 thousand pounds were Runners, and 16.0 thousand pounds were Spanish. October stocks of seed included 186 thousand pounds of Virginias and Valencias, 42.0 thousand pounds of Runners, and 15.0 thousand pounds of Spanish.

These Statistics are collected and presented according to the Peanut Statistics Act which requires shellers, crushers and processors of raw peanuts to submit periodic reports for their operations. These reports are usually based on a complete enumeration of all shellers and crushers and all of the larger processors of raw peanuts. However, reports are occasionally received too late to be included in the first tabulation. Allowances are made for these missing reports and revised totals are published in the next report.
